To be followed by Select Dog, Select Bitch, and Awards of Merit Best from the Regular Puppy Classes, Best from the Bred-By Exhibitor Classes, and Best from the Veterans Classes.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION ~ The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If at the end of the 90-day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

AWARDS OF MERIT ~ The judge may, at his/her discretion, present one Award of Merit for every 10 entries (up to 4) in the Best of Breed competition. The Award of Merit may <u>not</u> be awarded to exhibitors who have already been awarded Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog or Select Bitch; therefore, are already recognized. The Award of Merit is reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

The Club and its Show Secretary caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking/loading/ unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators and escalators, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry & of the holding of this event & of the opportunity to have the dog judged & to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary & the owner &/or lessor of the premises & any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, & I (we) personally assume all responsibility & liability for any such claim; & I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for & agree to indemnify, defend & save the aforementioned parties harmless from any & all loss & expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, & whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO, THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN AKC & THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) & MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION & EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETILED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES & GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e.,Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim & Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered & shown in Best of Breed competiton; Dogs that are Champions of Record & dogs which, according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
- 5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Óbedience, & Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire & Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
